

ARMSTRONG COUNTY COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

Armstrong County, along with the 66 other counties in Pennsylvania, are following the PA Department of Health “phased” roll out of the vaccine distribution. With initial supplies limited, the COVID-19 vaccine will be distributed to Pennsylvanians in four phases. **We're currently in Phase 1A** and have begun vaccinating those most at-risk of illness, such as health care workers and Pennsylvanians living in long-term care facilities, persons age 65 and older, and those age 16-64 with high-risk conditions.

Currently, those interested can sign up for the vaccine through ACMH hospital Klingensmith’s health care and Rite Aid pharmacy. Also, please check with your PCP or health care provider for vaccination information.

ACMH Hospital has currently suspended scheduling of new COVID-19 vaccinations for the general public due to the extremely low amount and inconsistent delivery of vaccine being provided by the PA Department of Health to their facility.
